



Manufacturer's Comment

Continuing high oil costs, shortages and deflated dollar values have created an era of energy conscientiousness. Americans have used their Old Mill stove as a supplement to their existing heating plant and many have found they can heat their entire home with an Old Mill stove. Independence from the high cost of home heat is the key factor.

Old Mill wood stoves are constructed of 100% welded 1/4" steel-plate throughout. The scenic cast iron doors have a tapered latch and rope gasket assuring positive lock and airtight seal for efficient combustion. Cast iron vent knobs control the precise amount of air entering the fire chamber, assuring reliable safe operation and a controllable pre-set rate of burn.

Old Mill has 6 sizes of wood stoves. The O.M. 25 and O.M. 35 are single door step stoves. The O.M. 50 Fireplace has double doors. All three models have double baffles to retain heat and reburn gases.

The three other models are fireplace inserts. The O.M. 15 is a single door, and the O.M. 45 and O.M. 55

are double door. The O.M. 45 is aimed to meet the shallow fireplace category. These three models have one large baffle in the firebox. The inserts will slide into your fireplace utilizing the existing flue. Optional Trim Kits are available for the inserts for those of you who wish to enclose the fireplace cavity. The Trim Kits are uniquely designed with a frame and a mesh screen which allows the hot air to flow from the fireplace opening and at the same time decoratively hides the cavity.

All of these stoves have been tested and listed by Arnold Greene Testing Laboratories to UL-1482 Standards and ANSI-UL-737. The Old Mill wood stoves also carry a 25 Year Limited Warranty.

Optional accessories such as: screens, chrome polished hinge pins and spring handles, chrome high-lighted doors and vent controls with black background, and blower tops are available for all models.

Truly a stove built with the workman's pocket book in mind.
