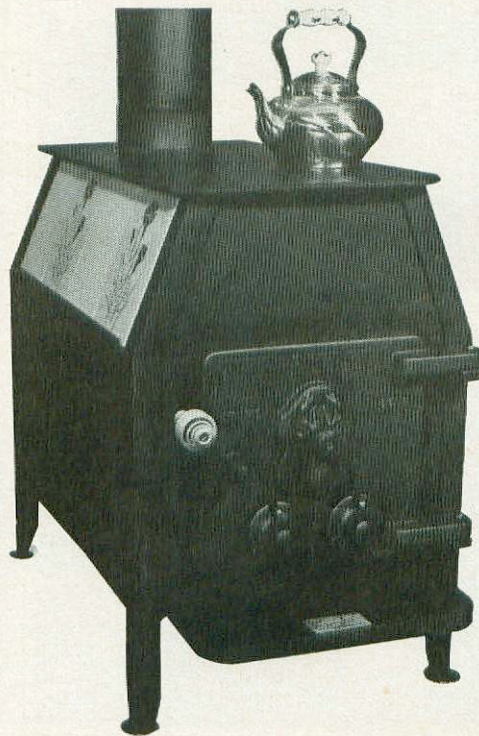


PINE BARREN Model HHPB-1 Piney 1



Manufacturer's Comment

Pine Barren Stoves, like the natives of the New Jersey Pine Barrens, are reliable, self-sufficient, warm friends that can save users up to 80% of current heating expenses.

The traditional freestanding model shown above is available in three sizes; the HHPB (log length 30 inches), the HHPB-I (log length 25 inches) and the HHPB-II (log length 19 inches).

All Pine Barren Stoves are safety tested to UL standards 1482 or 737, and listed by ETL Testing Laboratories. In addition, all units are registered with BOCA (RR #79-32), ICBO (TL-115) and the state of Massachusetts.

Popular and efficient features of Pine Barren's high heat (HH) series stoves are:

- a highly efficient heat exchanger for greater thermal performance (up to 20% additional BTU's with optional blower)
- a handsome, gasketed, high quality cast iron door to insure an airtight firebox
- $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{5}{16}$ inch quality steel plate body—will not warp or crack
- large firebrick lined firebox for long burns and long life

airtight firebox with infinitely adjustable primary and secondary drafts for complete command over your fire • Scandinavian-style baffle system combined with adjustable preheated secondary draft intake for more complete combustion.

Options include (1) a quiet operating 265 CFM blower, (2) bolt-on hot water tanks to supplement domestic hot water systems, (3) adaptor manifold to connect stove to existing hot air central system, (4) decorative ceramic tile kits to blend with most decor. (5) glass door to view the fire, and (6) brass or chrome plated primary drafts.
