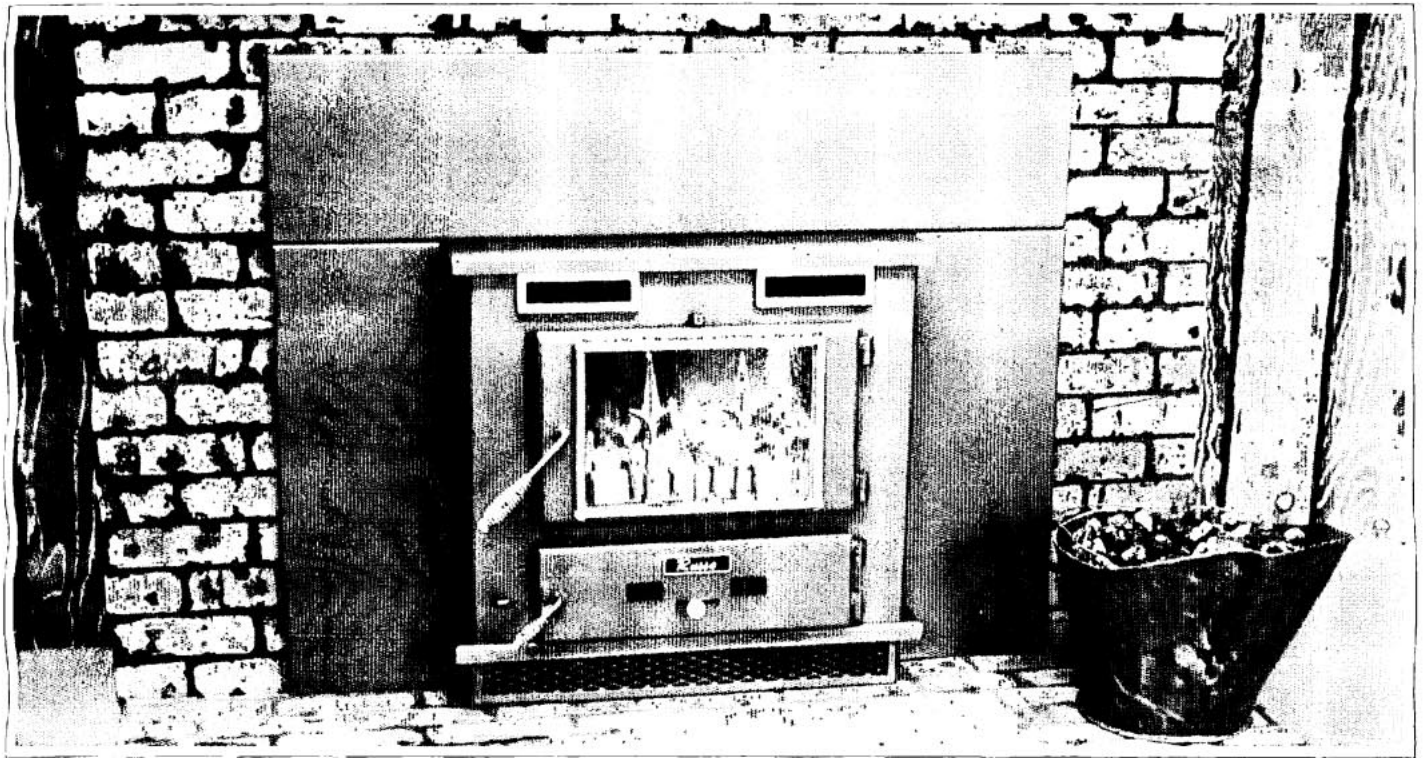


RUSSO Coal and Wood Insert



Manufacturer's Comment

The most recent addition to the Russo Hotline for 1981/1982 is a combination coal/wood fireplace insert that burns coal or wood, and heats up to 10,000 cubic feet of living space. The Russo insert will fit into a 25 1/2" fireplace opening; it can be adjusted for different fireplace depths or to suit your personal taste.

The Russo Coal/Wood Insert features a large Corning Vycor® window that provides a view of the fire. In addition, it has a large capacity heat exchange system that provides freely circulating convection heat. A thermostatically controlled blower to force this heat through the system is optional.

A single sliding air control regulates both the primary and secondary air. The unit also features a special high temperature poured refractory lining and a removable 3/16" steel baffle. The damper assembly is removable to allow for easy chimney cleaning.

The Russo insert has extra heavy duty cast iron rocker grates that are externally controlled for easy operation. The insert holds 40 lbs. of coal

or 18" logs which will enable it to burn easily throughout even the coldest nights. Best performance is obtained by burning nut size coal, although pea or stove sizes or a combination of wood and coal perform very well also.

Options include a mantle protection kit and a kit that enables the Russo insert's flue to be connected directly to the chimney.
