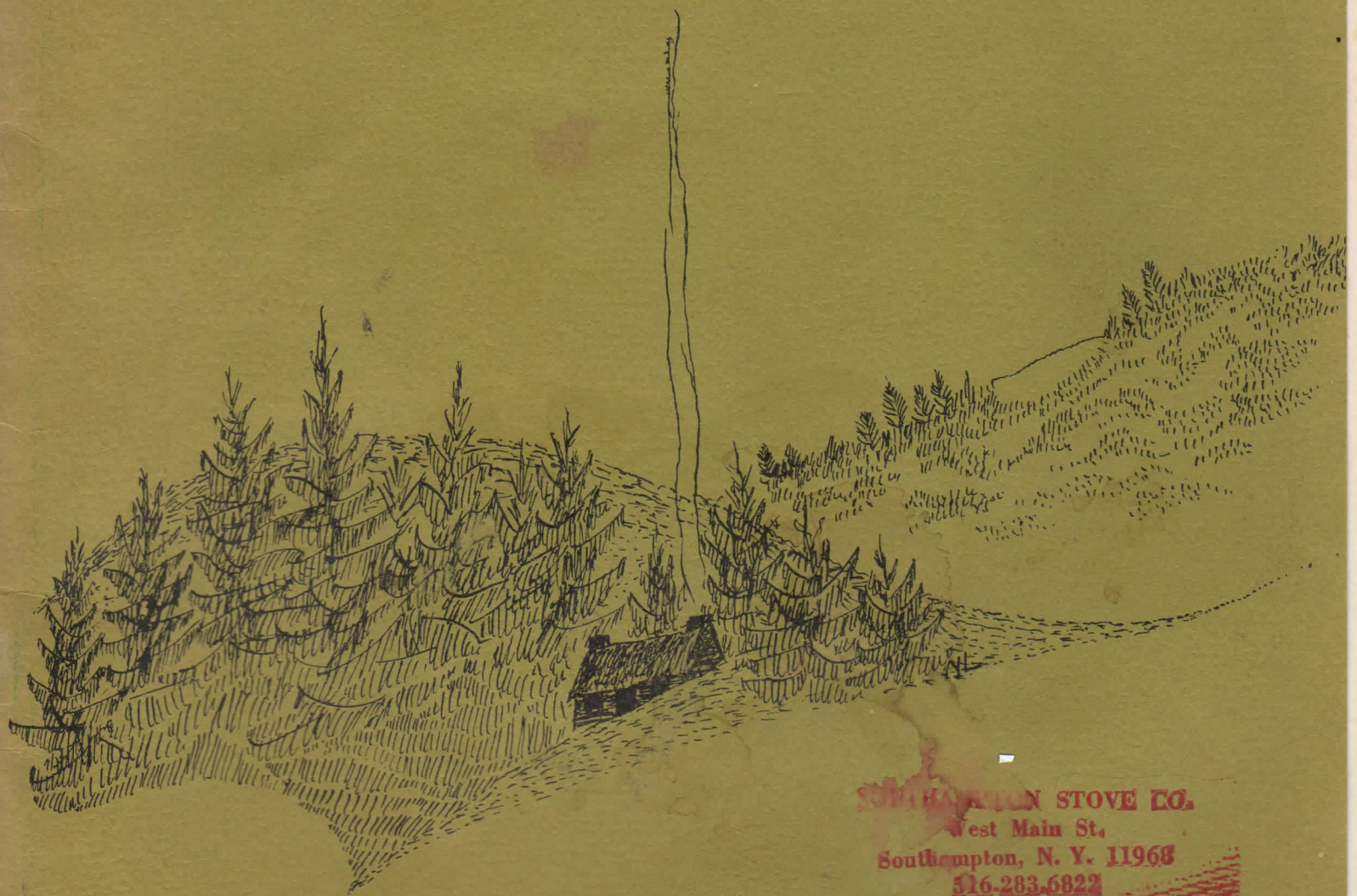

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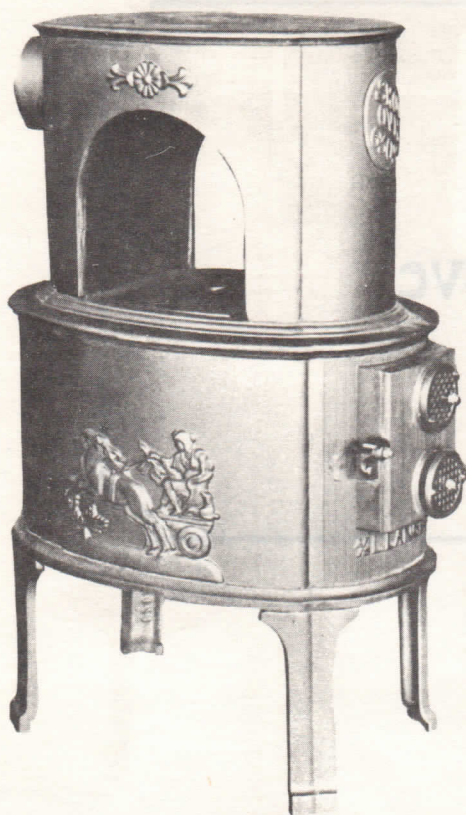

Lange Model 6303A and 6303B

This is an especially strong heater with a long firebox and big wood capacity for a small stove. Curved side plates add strength. All stove plates near fire, so no baffle is needed. Can be used for cooking. 6303B is the same stove with a flue outlet in the rear.

Lange Model 6303

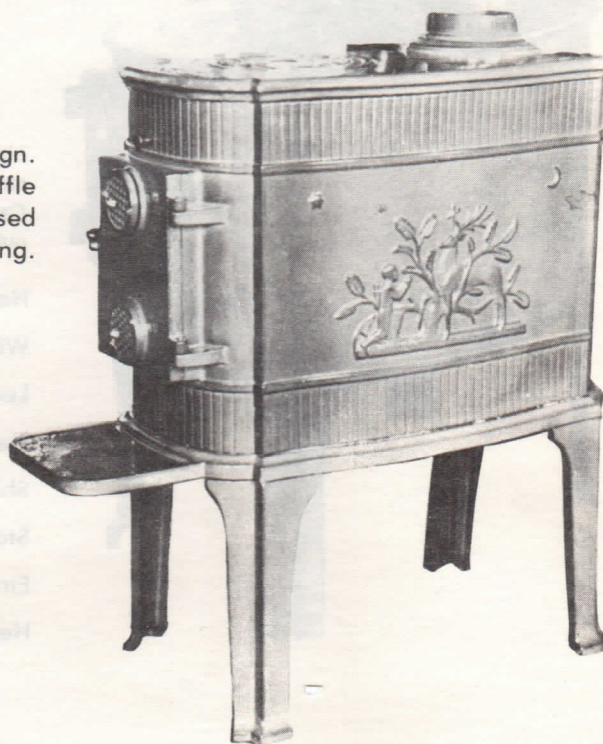
This stove has the same firebox as model 6303A, but with an extra heat chamber on top. This is an old Scandinavian device for getting more heat out of the same amount of wood.

Lange Model 6302A

This is a powerful heater of very sturdy design. Curved plates for extra strength. Unique baffle system for extra heat output. Baffle can be bypassed for quick-starting fire. Can be used for cooking.

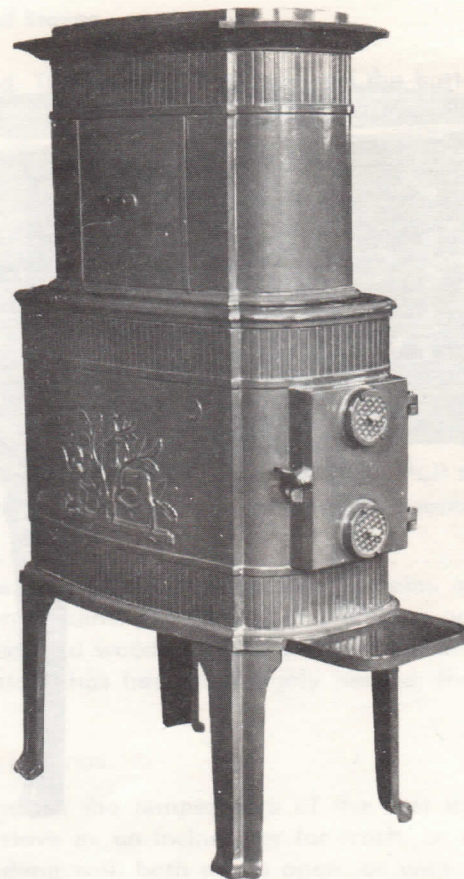

Lange Model 6302K

The base is the same as the 6302A, but a second heating chamber has been added. The chamber contains an oven (with vent for temperature regulation) and cooking plates. The "K" will heat a very large area, and handle cooking and baking at the same time.

Lange Model 6203BR

A parlor stove patterned after European tile stoves. Designed to offer a lot of heat in a relatively small package. Note stove's short length, but heavy weight and comparatively large radiating surface. Has typical Scandinavian horizontal baffle system.

Model 911W**

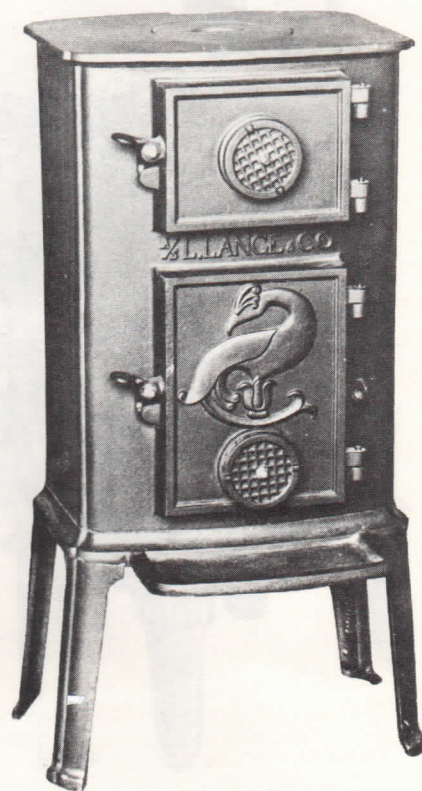
This cast iron range has a large firebox designed for wood. Firebox grate is easily removable to provide extra fuel space for longer burning. Tight construction, dual drafts and pre-heater.
