
Instructions for cleaning your stove



- 1. Acquire a 2 to 2 1/2' Choke Cable (this would be like an lawnmower choke cable, must be flexible but sturdy)
- 2. Put a slight bend on one end of the choke cable and put the other end into a corded or cordless drill or driver
- 3. Remove the brick in your stove (if you have brick)
- 4. Locate the two holes with plugs in them (one on each side of the drop chute)
- 5. Remove the combustion fan (this is a must)
- 6. Put the bent end of the Choke cable into the hole going toward the drop chute
- 7. Push the choke cable until it feels like you are stuck and then push a little harder
- 8. You will know that you are in the right area when you can see the end of the choke cable where the combustion fan was setting
- 9. Run the drill back and forth to knock off the soot
- 10. Vacuum everything up
- 11. Reinstall everything

Or you could do what is called the "Leaf Blower Trick" you can watch videos of this on You Tube. Just make sure that if this is done that the hose going to the vacuum switch is disconnected
